reaches the entrance to a small farm on the RHS continue ahead on a footpath up the 3.4km, 53mins barranco. After a few metres you pass the back entrance to the farm, cross to the other side of the barranco and continue ahead on the footpath. Just after a bend in the footpath re-join the track and turn R uphill. Continue ahead to reach a junction to the L 4.2km, 1hr 11 mins which runs out level to a small plateau with cultivated terraces to a ridge line beyond. Take this track, pass a ruin on the LHS and just before reaching the terraces watch out for a footpath continuing uphill to the R. (Y/W) The path turns back on itself and runs up parallel to a barranco on the LHS, descends a little before rising to eventually meet the barranco bottom. In the distance you soon see the Mas de Raco de Llobet above vou. Soon the path reaches the terraces, continues on a back to the RHS, curves around to the L before rising up to quickly meet a track at a water deposito which we ascend for a few metres to the corner of the fenced enclosure where we turn L to continue on the 5.3km, 1hr footpath. 32mins This quickly reaches the old building with seats outside. This is used by a local group of hunters, but you are welcome to borrow the seating. 5.5km, 1hr 35mins Continue ahead around to the L past a small building with a water pipe (normally with running water) and about 100m ahead there is a path going steeply uphill to the R 5.7km, 1hr which you take. 38mins Follow this relentlessly uphill for several hundred metres before it levels a little, meets a

Soon you get clear of the trees and can see that your path is going to take you to the crest the ridge.

second path joining from the L and then soon starts to track leftwards and more gently

Once you reach at a fingerpost then turn right and continue back along the ridge line on the LHS of the crest on a very clear path.

A little way along this the path turns to the R and you will see a track coming up to join you from a barranco and you quickly reach a col with fingerpost. (this marks your descent point so take note!!)

Here move slightly ahead and then leftwards on a broad track trending across the slope.

Round a shoulder still on this track and at a gate continue uphill to the R to quickly reach a col with a building – Refugio Montcabrer and just to the R of this a nevera (ice house) with explanatory info board.

Once soaked in the history of this activity return the way you came past the Refugio and towards the gate, but instead of going through this take the downward R turn on a broad track to reach the Cava Gran and even finer example of an ice cave.

Now return uphill to the gate, go through it and retrace your steps back to the col.

Here cross the col to continue on a Y/W path with fingerpost.

This descend steeply at first but then more gently using an engineered path to reach a level terrace which you cross directly in front of you to reach a track descending to the house – the Mas de Raco Llobet.	24mins 9.4km, 2hr 34mins	
Continue on the track you used earlier but do not take the footpath to the R. Ignore all side tracks going off which are entrances to houses/fincas.
