Title of Walk	Lliber circuit, including the Hidden Valley and Font D'Aixa	
Location of Start	Lliber

Directions to Start	Take the CV 745 from Jalon to Lliber. Cross over the bridge before entering the village, turn immediately L and park	
Short walk description	Good paths, tracks and quiet country roads with great views. A short steep ascent up from Font D'Aixa, through "the squeeze" to the ridge and it's downhill all the way back to Lliber.	
Full Walk Description		Elapsed Walking Time/Distance so far
With your back to the main road walk down the road between apartments on both sides. After 80m turn R then after 20m go L up a stone paved road. Turn sharp L again after a further 70m up to some gates and go L onto a paved path. After approx. 100m this path turns sharp R and up but you go straight onto an uncovered path. Continue to a fork and go R.(9mins, 597m)		9mins 0.60km
Proceed, past a sewage treatment works below on your LHS to a track (house on the corner) where you turn R onto this track. (13mins, 0.98km)		22mins, 1.58km
Continue up this track to a road where you turn L. (6mins, 0.51km)		28mins, 2.09km
After 50m cross a main road and continue on road opposite (ignore track on R) At a LH bend turn R onto a concrete covered track. (20mins, 1.62km)		48mins, 3.71km
After approx. 120m turn R down a path. Ignore path on your LHS after 50m and

proceed down into the valley and on to where the path joins a track. (20mins, 1.29km)	1hr8mins, 5.0km
Proceed down this track until it joins a road and turn R. (4mins, 0.32km)	1hr12mins,5.32m
Continue and cross a main road. (2mins, 0.19km)	1hr14mins,5.51k
The road now becomes more of a concrete covered track which crosses a barranco (km 6.13) past two paths that join from the RHS (km 7.44 and 7.67) and ends at "Font D'Aixa" (30mins, 2.38km)	1hr44mins,7.89k
Continue straight on the Y/W marked path and on to a path junction where you turn L signed "Castell d'Aixa per penyes" (10mins, 0.62km)	1hr54mins,8.51k
From here it's a steep steady climb, through "the squeeze" (with a small amount of exposure) and on to the summit which is a perfect spot for lunch with spectacular views. (25mins, 1.06km)	2hr19mins,9.57k
Take the path going down (ignore the Y/W cross near the start) follow the falling ridge to a ruin. (18mins, 0.79km)	2hr37min,10.36k
Continue past the ruin on your LHS and over a flat section before the zig zag descent begins. Proceed downhill, the path is not always clearly defined SO CONCENTRATE!> The final section of descent is on the RHS of the mountain down to a small barranco. (32mins, 1.46km)	3hr9min,11.82km
Cross the barranco and turn immediately L on the other side. Follow this path through the trees to a ruin on your RHS with a yellow spot on the wall. (6mins, 0.33km)	3hr15min,12.15k
Continue on the path to a barranco (sewage treatment works opposite so don't hang around!) (3mins, 0.18km)	3hr18min,12.33k
Cross barranco, bear to the R for about 40m to a path where you go R. This path soon becomes a track which joins another. (6mins, 0.42)	3hr24min,12.75k
Turn R onto this track which runs alongside the barranco. At a fork go R, cross the barranco and, a little later cross it back again and on to the cars. (8mins, 0.63km)	3hr32min,13.38k
