Directions to Start	Follow the CV720 out of Pedreguer towards Llosa and Alcalali. On the outskirts of the village there is a brown sign pointing to the L for the Ermita. Follow this road – initially Avenida Maria Lopez (and soon becomes Carrer del Migdia) Ignore any side turns to the L slanting downhill. The road narrows a little, goes across a crossroad and then reaches a T junction. Turn R (Carrer Passatge) and park		
Short walk description	A splendid walk on well-defined paths and tracks marked Y/W for the whole route. Great views particularly from the Castell summit (not to be missed). A tough ascent to the summit but well worth the effort and a lovely return home

Continue on this path, go straight on at a cross paths, and descend in zig zags to arrive at a picnic area and Font Coberta (24mins, 0.97km)	57mins, 3.04km		
Turn R up this track and continue past a house on your RHS, up past Font del Rull off to the LHS, nearly to the top to a finger post. (17mins, 1.04km)	1hr14min,4.08km		
Turn L here onto a track and after a few metres take the path on the R. This contours gently along the LH flank of the mountain, passes an indistinct path jnc. and reaches a clear junction where we take the LH descending path. This zig zags down with climbing crags down on the LHS to reach a terrace just above the valley floor. It turns across the barranco to the RHS and joins a track with two new building on each side. (20mins, 1.08km)	1hr34min,5.16km		
Proceed between these two building and immediately after the one on the L turn L onto a path. Follow this path down over two terraces bearing R then back onto the path. At a fork go L and down to a concrete surfaced road. Turn R here and continue to Font d'Aixa where the road ends. (16mins, 1.04km)	1hr50min,6.20km		
Continue straight ahead on a path to a finger post near a ruin. (11mins, 0.68km)	2hr1min, 6.88km		
Go straight on here signed"Castell d'Aixa pel Libre 2.37km". (here comes the tough ascent to the summit/castell) The path now takes you over Barranco de la Fondacha to the RHS. Press on, past a ruin on your RHS, and back over the barranco. Press on uphill with the barranco on your RHS. After a while the path bears R and crosses the barranco again, for the last time, then zig zags up a wide gully to a path junction with a post. (39mins, 1.86km)	2hr40min,8.74km		
Turn L and follow the path to the summit/castell. Return by the same route back to the post. (27mins, 1.24km)	3hr7min, 9.98km		
Proceed straight on here (the path to the R is the one you came up earlier) along the still clear marked path which initially runs on the RHS of the ridge then rises up a little on the L flank of the ridge and then runs along the L flank of this for some time. Eventually we crest the ridge and the path starts to run along on the RHS of the ridge line going downhill. After 100m of changing sides we arrive at a cross paths. (25mins,
