Directions to Start	Take the CV70 from La Nucia towards Guadalest. Pass the Km 34 sign and 0.7km further on take the minor surfaced road going off L (Sign for El Trestellador restaurant). Continue along this surfaced road ignoring road off L for 1.2km to a group of casas amidst trees and a trough which is near the Font Moli Ondara. This is the start and there is parking for several cars and more down the road.	
Short walk description	This is a long walk on the lower north side of the Aitana range. It is mainly on very good tracks which allows you to soak in the beautiful scenery. It commences with a pleasant walk to Partagas with amazing views of Guadalest. Other highlights are passing through an interesting rock slide, a beautiful hidden valley and a scramble up to castle ruins. There are a few stretches on paved roads but the scenery relieves the tedium. Save this walk for a clear day. For those who want a tougher walk, a few options are noted.

the track up sharp **R** over a **chain** barrier **A**. (9min .5km) 0.5km 3%

Continue up always bearing **R**. Ignore track **R B** with dead end sign and track **L**. Arrive at nevera (snow hole) **C** on **RHS**. (**16min 1km**) **1.5km 8%**

Continue up through a rocky gully and on to Corral de Senyores

on your RHS.

(10min .5km)

2.0km 12%

Continue along the main track to a **T-junction** E. (12min .8km) 2.8km 16%

Turn **R.** Ignore minor tracks **R** and **L** to reach junction with track above Partagas **F** (15mins 1.1km) 3.9km 21%

Turn **L** arrive at a junction. Take track **R** Signposted to Passet De La Rabosa. (*The track off L goes to the Port de Tagarina*) Follow the track which winds up to arrive at a path **R** indicated by a **Y/W** waymarker and another signpost **G** (in 2019 the track was chained off at end). **(9min .5km) 4.4km 24%**

Take this path which passes through a jumble of rocks, (possibly caused by a fall during an earthquake) to reach a col (1178meters) where path divides H. (10min .5km)
4.9km 27%

You take the **RH** path and after 20mtrs. take **LH** path (2019 very water worn) going down and across the valley aiming for the next col with a group of pines. Here at a cairn you join a feint track **K** and turn up **L**. (17min .8km) 5.7km 32%

Follow this track (ignore 2 tracks off **L**) as it curves around and down across the Barranco Barbaroja, with ruin on your **R** and pass ruin of Coral de Bernal on hillside on your **R**. Continue to meet a crosstrack at a shallow col **M**. (15min .9km) 6.6km 38%

Turn **R** up track and watch for cairn marking beginning of path. **(3min .1km) 6.7km 39%**

Take this path which skirts a valley on your L. Ignore all paths off L. Continue to reach a large cairn where the path turns sharp L N. (7min .5km) 7.2km 41%

Follow the path heading in a westerly direction to arrive at a beautiful valley with a casita and almond trees. The path descends steeply down the **S** side of the valley before crossing over to the **N** side to eventually meet a track **P**. **(16min .8km) 8.0km 46%**

Turn **R** and pass through a notch with a superb view of Benifato Castle. At a sharp **LH** bend find a cairn marking a path going down **R**. **(7min .4km) 8.4km 49%**

Take this path going steep down for a few meters and then levelling out **R** and aiming for the col on **RH** side of Castle. Continue on this path up to the col with a large cairn **S**. **(15min .7km) 9.1km 54%**

The Col offers some shelter from wind and sun and has superb views for a rest while the energetic make the very worthwhile scramble up the Castle by the "path" on the **NW** side. **(20min) 60%**

From the foot of the Castle cliffs find path down to meet a track. Wind down main track, with occasional red arrows, ignoring minor tracks off **L** and **R** to arrive at a T junction with green fence **T**.(30min 1.9km) 11.km 70%

Turn **R** skirting the fence. At end of fence continue straight on to casa gates. Bear **L** and continue down to meet a surfaced road at a bridge \underline{V} . (10min .5km) 11.5km 74%

Cross the bridge and follow the track up ${\bf L}$ to the main road ${\bf \underline{W}}$. (8min .6km) 12.1km 76%

2019 NEW PATH requires good map reading skills. If not confident go to "skipping new path"

Turn \mathbf{L} down road. Where road changes from concrete to blacktop find culvert on \mathbf{R} \mathbf{J} . Walk along bancale, down sharply at end. Continue following infrequent cairns to reach field with scree on its \mathbf{RHS} .Stay on \mathbf{LHS} of field to and beyond its' end. Shortly you will find very overgrown old track.Follow track to \mathbf{T} -junction \mathbf{L} . Turn \mathbf{R} and walk to \mathbf{Q} on map.

SKIPPING NEW PATH

Turn **L** down the road and look for new cement track going off **R X**. (6min .4km)

12.5km 78%

Follow this track, which after a while loses its surface, to reach a chain across track at a casa driveway **Q**. **(20min 1.2km) 13.7km 85%**

Take the feint track going up **R**. Keep climbing steeply on the **RHS** of the almond bancales until reaching the very highest point of the plantation. **(5min .2km) 13.9km 87%**

Find a feint path Y going up and over the ridge aiming at lowest point of ridge.

NOTE: If you still have spare energy, you can climb Font de Salines (see map).

Now look for a stone building (Coral de Senyores). Make your way to it and the track D (The easiest route is along the wide almond bancales). (9min .4km) 14.3km 90%

Turn L and retrace your steps back to Font Moli and your car(s). (31min 2km)
16.5km 100%

NOTE: Again, for those with spare energy, a nice path finishing with a track to **B** can be added.
