<b>Directions to Start</b>	Drive on the CV 755 to southeast from Guadalest. Some 1.5 km from Guadalest , turn sharp <b>L</b> and drive down 1.7 km on a pine shaded road, signposted to the Guadalest reservoir (Embalse de Guadalest) . Park by reservoir.
<b>Short walk description</b>	Circular walk around Guadalest water reservoir on mainly quiet track. Good Sunday before lunch walk.

### THE START

*Note that times quoted are walking time only. - no breaks.*

Elapsed Walking Time

Distance so far

Cross dam. Turn L along paved road signposted to Cumbre Aixorta. Ignore road R. Arrive at small bridge over the Guadalest river. (1h35min 6km)

Continue L. The road climbs quite sharply to the fountain of Beniarda. Continue past a swimming pool on your L, and soon after that, before reaching the Beniarda village, turn L on a wide track. The track descends close to the water level. A number of paths and tracks fork L to the reservoir - keep R and continue back to dam. (55min 3.4km)

2h 30min 9.4km
