From the Plaza Mayor to the N of the town hall turn beside Bar Beltran. Keep right past the church to dredirectly to descend some steps.		
At the bottom of these turn right a few metres and post. Ignore the first right and take the second righ		
Walk between buildings and continue downhill with yellow and yellow and white flashes.		250m, 4min
Reach an old bridge but turn right before it and keep right of the second		570m, 7.5min
to walk down a concrete track and once beyond more buildings turn left at a junction and then cross the next bridge and start up the track in zigzags.		1.1km, 13min
Around a spur to the left ignore any side tracks to the left and soon arrive at a small col with a finger post.		

COSTA BLANCA MOUNTAIN WALKERS - WALK DESCRIPTION

Follow the GR11 indications slightly left and still on a track which crosses a field and then turns left through a fence to the left and descends in zigzags to cross a stream bed at the bottom.

Arrive at a track junction where you go ahead through a gate with a finger post and cross the field diagonally and slightly downhill to arrive at a second gate through which you turn half left to walk down a grassy ramp and cross above a ditch.

3.5km, 41min

Follow the path into trees (box, yew and oak) till you meet a track junction just beyond an abandoned building where you turn right and gradually drop to meet the road.

4.2km, 50min

Cross this to the left across a parking area with benches and descend on a way marked footpath steeply downhill.

After a considerable descent arrive at Can Serra, (and Casa Etxalde) a sprawling set of accommodation and walk directly ahead through this and onto a track.

5km, 1hr 3min

Climb up this track until you reach a bend with a finger post where you continue ahead descending across a field. (Views ahead of Coma Negra a significant peak)

5.6km, 1hr 12min

Quickly double back to the right at a post and reach a track which you descend.

When you meet a bigger track turn right downhill. Walk down to a junction where you swing left at a finger post and then turn right at signs to descend, soon on a footpath at a finger post - to a collection of farm houses.

7km, 1hr 31min

Here there is a cross roads where you must go effectively straight down after negotiating the right and left. This cobbled lane leads downhill and you cross a stream and rise on the other side until you start descending on a partially cobbled footpath.

Pass a small ruined casita and then more substantial ruined farmhouse. Beyond this drop down steadily to reach a road where you continue ahead a short distance to find a footpath leaving on the right at a finger post.

8.7km, 1hr 54min

Cross a delightful bridge at the edge of a deep gorge and on the far side work back uphill. Cross another bridge to the right and then work your way up to eventually meet the road.

9.9km, 2hr 13min

(There is a slightly pointless path opposite this point which climbs above the road for a short distance)

Better simply to turn left along the road and a little way down find a finger post and pate down to the left.

10.4km, 2hr 17min

Take this very rocky route to emerge on a rough area immediately opposite the village car park. Turn left down into the village.
