## COSTA BLANCA MOUNTAIN WALKERS - WALK DESCRIPTION Cross a small valley and immediately turn R just above the streambed to follow this down and meet a track where you turn L quickly passing a small white casita. 3.1km, 55min This soon becomes concreted and a few hundred metres down this look out for some faded pink arrows on a small wall on the LHS where you turn steeply uphill on a footpath. 3.4km, 1hr 1min This rough path alternates between level stretches and (later) a steep rough section to reach a col from where you plunge down the far side. Continue until just before some cultivated terraces where you find a pain mark indicating a footpath turning L back up the hill. 4.3km, 1hr 23min Continue until you pass a ruined casita where you plunge quite steeply down to the river bed. Turn R a few metres along this and then clamber L and up through between canes and mata (green leaved bushes) to reach a terrace. Keep to the RHS of this and walk up some steps and then a ramp to continue ahead to reach a very broad track. Turn R along this. 4.7km, 1hr 30min Walk down this for 100m and turn L onto a track with a chain and walk uphill before turning R and more level. When this runs back down to a tarmac road join this and continue ahead on the tarmac around bends and following occasional signs towards Forna. When this drops down into a barranco and doubles back to the R leave the tarmac and 6.2km, 1hr 52min continue ahead on a track soon passing to the L of a fence and crossing the barranco to gain a footpath which climbs steeply for 10m and then runs level above the barranco. At a feint junction keep R on the clearer path and descend to join the barranco where you turn L. After 50m look up to see a striking conifer with a single ball of foliage at the top and just past this find a cairn indicating a footpath rising steeply to the R. 6.6km, 1hr 59min Follow this up to to finally reach a past marker in a cairn and turn L now following a line of poles uphill to soon walk to the RHS of a fenced enclosure. This path passes close to a white chiringuita (bar) but fails to visit it continuing instead

uphill to arrive at a paved road where you turn L descending (R will take you up to the castle)

Follow this to arrive at a road where you turn R and walk down to the parking area just outside the village.
