Drop down a little to cross a small valley and then ascend on a footpath soon rising steadily in zig-zags.	
After some time climbing this arrive at some terraces and then join a track where you turn R.	2.8km, 50min
Quickly pass a hunter's casita on the LHS and then swing around L rising to reach a junction where you turn R.	3.1km, 54min
Follow this up now ignoring a track going off to the L (3.7km, 1hr 3min) to reach a col with sweeping views and from here descend still on the track.	4.5km, 1hr 15min
700m alter just opposite a partially completed house on the RHS take a track to the R opposite.	5.2km, 1hr 26min
(It would be possible to descend a little further and take the next track L after another 70m and join the point at 5.7km continuing ahead)	
Follow this until it runs out onto a terrace and then continue to the far side of the terrace and turn R downhill keeping to the LHS of the terraces.	
Once these become tricky (after about 200m) swing over to the RHS of the terraces and here join a track where you turn L.	5.7km, 1hr 35min
At a jnc turn R (away from the house) and now head S to meet another T-jnc where you turn L.	6km, 1hr 40min
When you reach a junction with a finger post turn R and at the road turn L for about 100m and turn R at a large sign board up a very broad track.	6.9km, 1hr 51min
Swing around to the R past a house under construction (good spot for lunch?) and then ahead passing a junction and starting to descend.	
When you reach a further junction where there is concrete directly ahead turn R on a track with Y/W and follow this out to the road once more where you turn L.	8.3km ,2hr 11min
Continue until just before the chevrons of a LH bend and here turn R dropping down a track to quickly join a partially concrete track and follow this downhill.	
The "safe" way to continue now is to reach a track joining you from the L and turn back along it. (If you are observant then about 50m before the junction you will see a small footpath dropping L to cut the corner and once on the track below you turn L.)	8.6km, 2hr 17min
Continue ahead now ignoring side turnings and when the track swings slightly L and uphill look out for a footpath continuing directly ahead and take this.	
Follow this gently uphill to reach a col and intersection with a track and here continue directly ahead on a track descending.	9.4km, 2hr 27min
Only a few metres down this take a signed footpath down to the RHS and now follow this zig-zag engineered path as it steadily descends, taking care to avoid paths going off onto the terraces. (Soon marked with R/W)	

## COSTA BLANCA MOUNTAIN WALKERS - WALK DESCRIPTION Join a broad track soon swinging across a barranco still descending and reach a tarmac road which you cross directly to continue your descend on a track. At a junction swing around to the R still descending and soon reach the tarmac road once more where you must turn L. Once you pass a junction on the LHS with a sign to El Castellet, take the R turn after this to walk around a barranco and then slightly uphill and into the village and your car park.
