| instruction. The track goes ahead steeply in zig-zags and when you pass a fenced finca on the RHS the track deteriorates a little, plateaus and descends a little. There is a junction with a signpost to the LHS (Bodoix) and we turn L to follow this up soon in zig-zags. | 2.5km, 39min | |
