However before reaching the parking area look carefully for Y/W and R/W waymarks indicating a rising line on your LHS away from the obvious path and follow this up to crest the ridge and drop down almost immediately on a traversing path downhill overlooking a spectacular valley on your LHS.

5.2km, 1hr 44min

Along this section there are several slightly vague sections across grass where you must carefully hunt out the continuing waymarks and in particular as you reach a small ruin on the LHS you must drop down beside this to find the ongoing path.

9.9km, 3hr 6min

Finally arrive above the river with a footbridge visible below you and follow the path slightly beyond this before doubling back to reach the bridge which you do NOT cross.

Instead, stay on the same side and look for the R/W markers which lead you out onto a grassy ledge and from this the path starts to descend steadily mostly in woodland.

After a short while this section also has some slightly vague sections especially after rounding a spur so it pays to keep hunting out the waymarks.

After you cross a rocky promontory there is a short section of paved path and a little further on a signed font on the LHS quickly followed buy a building on the RHS. In the distance you can see a track descending down the valley in front of you.

A short steep section leads down to a track where you turn L.

13.1km, 4hr

Walk around a doubling back curve to the R and then take care to look out for a footpath leaving on the LHS only a few metres ahead dropping steeply and follow this down to meet a concreted track again at a building.

13.6km, 4hr 9min

Cross this directly to find the footpath continuing to descend.

Rejoin the track and continue ahead ignoring a footpath going off to the R and continue R at a finger post at a track junction.

Ignore a further track going off L and continue descending to go around a hair pin to the R and immediately look for a signed footpath leaving downhill to the L and take this.

14.7km, 4hr 24min

Reach a building immediately after which is a concrete track and set of gate posts and you pass to the R of these to continue on a grassy footpath.

15km, 4hr 30min

Meet the concrete road again and continue ahead quickly passing a tower on the RHS and walking ahead on a crazy paved road ignoring any side turnings and walking into the village.

When you meet tarmac descend to a junction where you find a footpath continuing straight ahead descending on wooden steps to meet the main road.

15.6km, 4hr 40min


Turn L here and make your way back to the rack railway station at Queralbs.
