| Directions to Start | Cercedilla is reached to the NW of Madrid from the AP6 motorway at junction 47. The M614 and M622 lead to the village with the railway station on the outskirts. Take the railway from here or drive up to Puerto de Navacerrada on the M622 and M601. | |
| Short walk description | A walk over a summit clad with radio equipment followed by an easy ascent of a rocky top leading to tough barranco descent and then easier and more enjoyable return routes through forest and across a ridge. | |

| Continue directly ahead with the trig point slightly off to your R and soon find an eroded path descending down the ridge line. | | | |
| This soon swings slightly to the R (ignore a less obvious path going off slightly L) aiming for the obvious col directly in front of La Maliciosa. | | | |
| The col has a construction similar to a milk churn on stilts – a rain gauge. | 4.8km, 1hr 23min | | |

Drop down over the ridge just a few metres to intercept a path going to the R with Y/W markers and follow this back to the now obvious buildings at the Puerto.

Walk Recommendations or restrictionsThe descent from the col between Bola del Mundo and Maliciosa is unpleasant.
