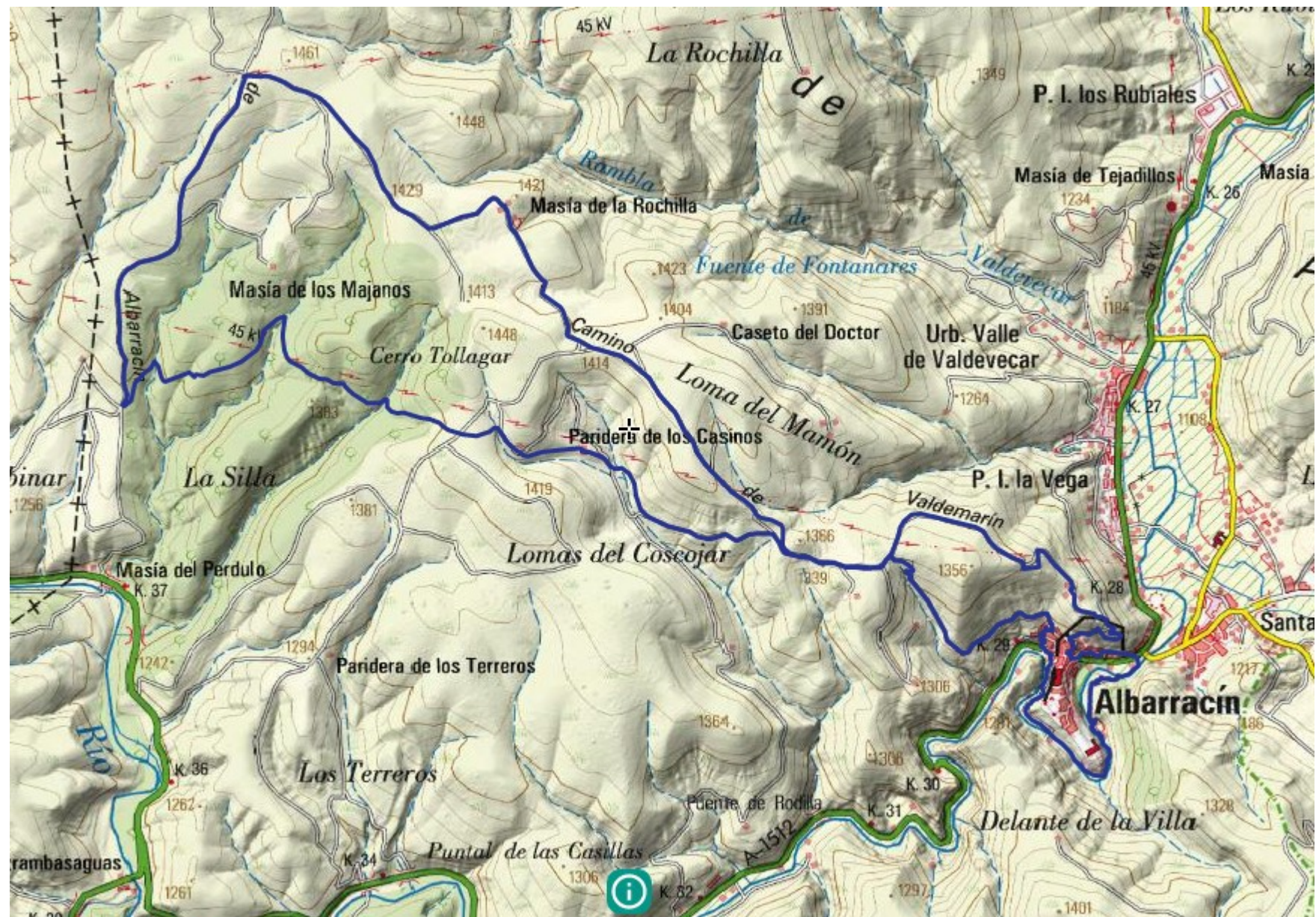

Directions to Start	From the A23 motorway running from Valencia NW past Teruel. Albarracin lies roughly NW of Teruel on the A1512 road. Park on the outskirts at the tourist info office car park.
