Turn R at the top and slightly downhill in the Carrer de l'Arena to reach a roundabout where we go straight across and onto a track.		400m, 6min	

COSTA BLANCA MOUNTAIN WALKERS - WALK DESCRIPTION

At a junction turn L uphill to arrive at some steps that lead up to a roundabout (the main CG2 road) which we cross at the lower level to mount some steps with a finger post. to Lac d'Engolasters (1hr 50min) 720m, 11.5min Cross a footpath cross roads and at the next junction with a sign go L steeply uphill. 970m, 16.5min Pass a finger-post to Cami del Fener de L'Olla and ignore this and keep uphill in zigzags. Finally reach 2 restaurants at the end of the lake – La Dama del Lac on the RHS gets the morning sun. 2.6km, 58min Once at the Restaurant de Dama de Llac walk across the terrace to a finger post and keep to the RHS of the lake on the higher track. At the end of the water keep right slightly uphill for a few meters before descending to a finger post and turning left walking below the dam. 3.6km, 1hr 13min Keep right towards a building with a large redundant water valve and the right again towards a large gate in a fence where you swing left still uphill to reach a track junction. 3.9km, 1hr 18min Turn right and now walk level soon on tarmac passing several building on the LHS the last of which is adorned with graffiti on its end wall. Keep ahead at a junction to soon reach a bigger road that sweeps around from right to left above a car park. Cross this immediately and step up onto a thin footpath..... 4.5km, 1hr 28min that soon broadens and gently climbs above pastures on the RHS towards a col. 5.5km, 1hr 45min Here there is a finger post..... and we keep ahead soon descending steeply to reach a charcoal burning exhibit (carboners) and the broad track below. 6km, 1hr 56min Here turn right and continue to reach a tarmac road and turning circle. 8.2km, 1hr 26min Immediately turn left descending on a track which becomes very steep before easing off and passing a ford and then reaching tarmac. 8.9km, 2hr 39min Follow this road down to reach a more major road which you cross and then drop down a footpath (with sign) directly across from you. 9.7km, 2hr 50min This stone flagged path descends with steps and then paying to turn left beside a stream and then gives out to an earth path which soon reaches a road. Turn right and in 10m left following the road down to a roundabout. Cross this on the RHS and then walk back to cross in front of the entrance to the cable car and then turn right down another set of stone flagged steps.

COSTA BLANCA MOUNTAIN WALKERS - WALK DESCRIPTION

At the bottom of these turn right onto tarmac rising briefly and when this road turns abruptly right keep ahead onto a footpath which turns down left beside the river to reach tarmac.

Turn left here, reach the main road and cross it to descend ahead on a stone flagged path to the car park.
