

Directions to Start	The CG2 is the main road through Andorra arriving from Spain in the south and continuing to exit into France in the north. Driving past all the major towns you eventually arrive at Canillo ad here turn L at a roundabout at a Total petrol station and here turn L. Follow the road up through zig-zags to finally arrive at the col with a car park for about 20 cars just as you start to descend. Alternatively take the same road from Ordino town towards Canillo.	
Short walk description	A stiff pull at altitude up a long and open ridge with extensive views across much of the Pyrenees from the summit.
