Directions to Start	Arriving on the A7207 at the SE outskirts of the village Fabrica de la Luz is signposted up a road on the RHS. Follow the signs all the way to the end of the road and park near the Recreation Area.	
Short walk description	A high level traverse along forest tracks to the Puerto Blanquillo with extensive views down the valley and out towards the sea followed by a delightful descent down an interesting barranco.

Start by walking ahead (N) and crossing the stream ahead up the concreted track to find a set of zig-zag		
Eventually reach a ridge and track junction where you turn R and up along the ridge.		1.7km, 35min
Soon keep R at a junction on a rougher track rising on the R flank of the hill.		
Keep ahead where a track joins you from the L and now walk level to work your way around several barrancos until you reach a lonely farm up on a knoll on the LHS. Keep ahead now starting to rise again.		3.9km, 1hr 23min

## COSTA BLANCA MOUNTAIN WALKERS - WALK DESCRIPTION generally level before starting to descend towards the obvious Puerto Blanquillo – a distinct col – ahead of you. 10.7km, 3hr 52min Once you reach this turn R on a now broad descending track. As you have approached the col you will have seen across the valley a steeply descending path dropping into the barranco and you must now watch out for this on the RHS of the descending track after only 200m Take this and drop down awkwardly to begin with soon levelling out and working down the L side of the barranco before crossing to the RHS and climbing briefly to avoid difficulties in the barranco bed. Soon resume your descent and pass below a ruined Cortijo (farm house) on your RHS 12.1km, 4hr 41min then crossing a subsidiary barranco and working along outside the fencing of a vegetable and fruit tree plot. Eventually join a track coming own from the RHS and work down steep concrete to reach the barranco bed where you turn R into the barranco on a footpath continuing downhill. 13.1km, 5hr 13min Arrive at a track which you follow rising slightly. 13.6km, 5hr 24min When you reach a track junction just beyond a water deposito (now with views across to some extensive walled caves) on your RHS keep R descending to reach farmhouse gates where our footpath drops in zig-zags on the RHS. 14.3km, 5hr 41min
