Directions to Start	Approaching from Denia on the CV700 at the Coop petrol station turn R at the roundabout. Proceed over 2 more roundabouts and at a T-jnc turn L. Proceed past Mercadona on your LHS and take the next R into Via Pista. Proceed for 1.15km approx., turn sharp left, staying on Via Pista. Starting point is about 350m further down this road.	
Short walk description	A circuit from Pego over this intermediate ridge with wide views N and S with an easy start and finish. Could be a pre-lunch walk!	
Full Walk Description		Elapsed Walking Time/Distance so far
From the parking, walk along Via Pista -to take a turning on your RHS – Camí d'Alques - with a sign post towards Mostalla.		100m, 1.5min
Walk ahead around a zig-zag to the R and L and then at a T-jnc ahead of you bend slightly L uphill to a finger post.		
Follow this uphill to find a footpath climbing steeply up the hill and follow this.		0.8km, 11min
The path relents briefly to cross a small outlying hill and then rises more gently on the RHS along a terrace.		1.4km, 26min
Soon you bear L and climb more steeply again and bear to the R flank of the hill continuing to climb before reaching a col with rocky seats available.		2.2km, 47min

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Now continue ahead on the RHS of the ridge until you eventually cross to the L as you start to descend with Pego now stretched out in front of you.	3.6km, 1hr 18min		
Reach a finger post pointing to Cova de l'Ase off to the L. This interesting cave has a chain supported descent and ascent of some 50m and a tricky entrance area. Worth it for the intrepid.	3.9km, 1hr 25min		
Reach a finger post and turn slightly R to work along parallel to cultivated terraces off to the L.			
After descending a complex barranco reach a track with a finger post and turn R.	4.3km, 1hr 33min		
At the next track junction turn R.	4.4km, 1hr 35min		
Reach a strange building on stilts and pass this on the L and immediately past it turn R now walking down a barranco.	4.8km, 1hr 41min		
Pass a small ruin on the LHS and soon after this turn L at a track junction now in the middle of a ruined camp site with huge swimming pool. (A good place to sit for lunch!)	5.1km, 1hr 45min		
Follow this concrete road down and after the concrete changes to a newer surface look out for a turning to the L, almost track proportion at first but quickly narrowing to footpath width.	5.5km, 1hr 51min		
Follow this as it climbs steadily to reach a col and here swing slightly R to reach a track where you continue directly ahead.	6.3km, 2hr 04min		
Reach a junction with a finger post where we keep R.			
Climb a little and then drop to a T-jnc with an interesting stone structure just off to the RHS with a dome and very deep pit. (Forn de Calc – Lime Pit??) Turn L at this junction.	6.7km, 2hr 12min		
Follow this tarmac road down through several zig-zags ignoring side turnings until you reach a junction where you turn L.	8.5km, 2hr 35min		
Reach a junction with a "Yield" sign – Carrer Carretjar (with a finger post pointing back the way you have come) and here turn R.	8.7km, 2hr 39min		
Proceed until you meet a dry river bed - Barranc de Mostalla (Google Maps has "Barranc de Mixel") - this runs from right to left. Turn L and continue along this dry water course.	8.8km, 2hr 42min		
The barranc meets a roadway. Cross the road and continue along the barranc.	9.3km, 2hr 51min		
Where the barranc meets the next roadway, cross the road and continue along the barranc.	9.6km, 2hr 57min		
For the third time, the barranc meets a roadway - the Via Pista. Turn L and proceed back to the starting point.	10.3km, 3hr 11min
