<b>Directions to Start</b>	Benissa 38.7312051, 0.0556632 On the roundabout in Benissa take the exit before the AP7 slip road (Partida Bonaire)signed Cemetery, after 150 metres turn left at sign, after 200 metres turn left at T junction onto Cami de Canor.
<b>Short walk description</b>	This walk is named after the Riberers or labourers who used this track when harvesting produce. The start is a gentle 4km before starting to climb. most of the walk is on good tracks except rocky and rough underfoot near the peak of Serrellars.
