Once you are nearly at the bottom you reach a finger post where you continue ahead signed to the Refugi de Rialb.

3.6km, 1hr 16min

Continue rising steadily with the river on your L to pass a set of BBQ's and the Font Freda and reach a finger post beside a bridge on your L. Ignore this and continue ahead to reach the now visible Refuge.

5.5km, 1hr 56min

Once lunch has been consumed, return by the same path passing the picnic area and staying close to the river to pass a building on your RHS and down through the trees to your car park.
