Directions to Start	From the CV-610 in Llutxent take the CV-608 to Pinet. Park at the roadside just before entering the village.	
Short walk description	Essentially this is a there and back walk with a few deviations. Crossing wild open, peaceful countryside above the small, somewhat isolated, village of Pinet. Lots of straightforward tracks and paths, though much of the route is unmarked. Passing through an area of Botanical interest. Some terrific views, particularly from the mirador. An abundance of flowers in the spring.	
Full Walk Description	Elapsed Walking Time/Distance so far	
Walk up the road towards the village. Turn first R onto a cami, just before a house gable end on which there is a mural. Go straight ahead, ignoring side roads, to reach a 'T' junction. Turn L up the road until soon, at a bend, you reach two tracks on the right.	8min, 549m	
Turn R and take the righthand, lower, track. In about 60 metres, where an olive grove on the left ends, there is a path (cairn). Turn L and follow the path which descends into a barranco and up the other side. The path levels off and passes through trees to reach a terrace. Here turn R and step down to a lower terrace. Turn L along it and soon reach a surfaced cami.	17min, 942m	
Follow it downhill until a junction with another concrete cami on the left is reached. Turn sharp L and go steeply up. When the concrete ends continue to reach two quarries, where there are bee hives so beware!	28min, 1.6km	

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<p>Between the quarries there is a narrow path leading uphill (cairn). Follow the unmarked but quite obvious path (recently cut at the time of writing). It undulates at first then rises steadily, until it intersects with a broad track at a bend.</p>	<p>1hr 17min, 3.5km</p>
<p>Turn L, downhill, along the track. Ignore a path, beside a burnt post, through the trees on the right (it becomes badly overgrown). Continue to a 'T' junction with another broad track. This is the picnic area of 'Bassa del Surar' and is an area of Botanical interest, with numerous information boards.</p>	<p>1hr 31min, 4.4km</p>
<p>Turn R and in a few meters reach a signpost at the edge of the picnic area. Turn L along a path signed to 'Alt de la Lletrera and Els Miradors' PR-CV 434 D3 (Y/W & orange markers). This path has botanical information boards at intervals along its length. At a junction with a signpost keep L. Signed to 'Alt de la Lletrera' PR-CV 434 D4. Continue along a less obvious path, a little overgrown but not scratchy. It winds along then climbs up, weaving about, to reach the summit (719m).</p>	<p>2hr 02min, 5.8km</p>
<p>Return back along the path to the previous junction with signpost. Turn L signed to 'Els Miradors' and follow the undulating path to reach the rocky platform at the view point. There are more view points several meters further to the right.</p>	<p>2hr 30min, 7.2km</p>
<p>Return back along the path to the previous junction with signpost, once again. Turn L and follow the (outward) path back to the picnic area of 'Bassa del Surar'.</p>	<p>2hr 56min, 8.6km</p>
<p>Turn L, signed to 'La Barraca de Pedra' PR-CV 434 V4, along the track. Descend a concrete section. Just after the concrete ends, ignore a vague path on the right going through woodland. Continue along the track, more of which is concrete, to pass beside a refugio. Here there are wide open views to the south. Just after a bend the concrete ends, here there is a track on the right with a metal barrier.</p>	<p>3hr 23min, 9.4km</p>
<p>Turn R, past the barrier and ascend the track. After a righthand bend the angle eases, then as you begin to descend at another righthand bend, a path branches off left. This is the path you ascended earlier and is unmarked.</p>	<p>3hr 28min, 10.3km</p>
<p>Descend this path, taken on your outward journey, to the quarries with the bee hives (beware)!</p>	<p>4hrs 2min, 12.2km</p>
<p>Go straight ahead down the track, which becomes concrete, to a junction. Bare L downhill to the bottom where, next to multiple junctions there is 'Font del Castell' on you right (partly hidden by vegetation).</p>	<p>4hr 8min, 12.6km</p>
<p>Go straight along on the surfaced cami bearing R up towards chicken sheds. At a junction turn R onto 'Via Pecuaría'. Continue uphill until the angle eases, where, just as you reach the corner of the second shed there is a track on the left.</p>	<p>4hr 12min, 12.9km</p>
<p>Turn L along the track which reduces to a path where it passes beside and then between a couple of casitas, after which it becomes a track again and leads to the main road. Turn R to return to the roadside parking.</p>	<p>4hr 16min, 13.3km</p>
